All shelters have access to grills.

PARK REGULATIONS

- Unauthorized motor vehicles are prohibited.
- Hours: Sunrise to Sunset.
- Alcoholic beverages, drugs and weapons are prohibited.
- Dogs must be kept on leashes at all times.

PICNIC SHELTERS

The Shelter Rental Agreement for renting shelters at Allen Jay Park, Armstrong Park, Cedrow Park, Deep River Park and Macedonia Park may be obtained from our office at 136 Northpoint Avenue. Policies and procedures are listed with this document. When renting a shelter, applicant must obtain and fill out completely a Shelter Rental Agreement Contract and pay in full for the shelter before the reservation is confirmed. This contract will serve as your permit for the use of the shelter. **No shelter reservation is confirmed or complete until all documentation and payment is received at our office.**

There will be a \$25.00 deposit required for a key to the restroom facilities. Once the key is returned, the deposit will be refunded. **We accept key deposit payments only in the form of a personal or business check.**

- Applicants must be of 18 years of age and must submit an application in writing to the High Point Parks and Recreation Department at 136 Northpoint Avenue.
- Applicants must read in detail the Rules and Regulations that comes with the lease agreement.
- Applicants must describe in detail the purpose of their use.
- The High Point Park Rangers will patrol the shelter areas and assist patrons as needed.
- The Parks and Recreation Staff will assist applicants with the type of shelter rental in regards to the type of rental use.

Restroom Facilities

Outdoor restrooms at all parks and shelters are closed for the winter from November until April. The water is turned off and the pipes are drained to prevent damage from freezing.
