This search will only return books mentioning *apps* that have a publication date of 2012 or later. The end of the range, 2099, is automatically generated as a placeholder – if the "to" date is left blank, the results will be limited to *only* books published in 2012.


The "View" options affect how much detail is displayed for each search result. The "Sort results by" options change the order in which results are shown: **relevance** puts the best matches to your search query at the top; **title**, **contributor** [author], and **publisher** sort alphabetically; **date** lets you put the newest or oldest books at the top of the list.

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
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
