**RESOLUTION**  
**FINDING THE HIGH POINT URBAN AREA 2040 METROPOLITAN**  
**TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP) AND THE 2016-2025 METROPLITAN**  
**TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (MTIP) ARE IN**  
**CONFORMITY WITH THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (SIP)**

**WHEREAS**, the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (MAP-21) requires all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) to develop and maintain a long range metropolitan transportation plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) is the recognized transportation decision making body for the transportation planning process in the High Point Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

**WHEREAS**, that conformity determination used the latest planning assumptions approved by the High Point Urban Area MPO; and

**WHEREAS**, that conformity determination used the latest emissions model approved by the United States EPA and was made according to the established interagency consultation procedures for North Carolina; and

**WHEREAS**, this area was re-designated from non-attainment to maintenance for the 1997 PM 2.5 Standard effective December 19, 2011, and

**WHEREAS**, the 2016-2025 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) is a direct subset of the High Point Urban Area 2040 MTP; and

**WHEREAS**, the projects in the High Point Urban Area 2040 MTP have been financially constrained; and

**WHEREAS**, the programs and projects included in the High Point Urban Area 2040 MTP are consistent with the SIP emissions budgets for the area based on a regional emissions analysis; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the High Point Urban Area Transportation Advisory Committee has made a finding that the High Point Urban Area 2040 MTP and the 2016-2025 MTIP conforms to the purposes of the SIP in accordance with the Clean Air Act as Amended (CAAA).
