CELEBRATE THE FOURTH AT HIGH POINT'S UNCLE SAM JAM

HIGH POINT, N.C. (June 18, 2018) – Celebrate the Fourth of July at the Uncle Sam Jam with High Point Parks & Recreation, the host of this local tradition since 1973. In addition to food, beverage and novelty vendors and the Family Fun Zone for kids, this year's Uncle Sam Jam will feature a live, family-friendly musical performance from *Earth to Mars: The Bruno Mars Experience*.

Gates open at Oak Hollow Festival Park, 1841 Eastchester Drive, at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 4. Admission cost is \$10 per vehicle. Food, beverages and novelties will be sold by onsite vendors. The Family Fun Zone features inflatables, a rock climbing wall and a bungee trampoline for kids, and an all-inclusive pass for this area is \$20 per child. The fireworks show over Oak Hollow Lake will begin at 9:45 p.m.

Coolers, chairs and blankets are allowed, but as the Uncle Sam Jam is a family-friendly event, no alcohol will be permitted and entrants should be prepared for bag and cooler checks at the gate. Tents, glass containers, fishing equipment, fireworks, grills and drones are prohibited. Pets are not allowed. Oak Hollow Lake will close to boats at 7 p.m.
