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OAK HOLLOW LAKE BRIDGE PRESERVATION PROJECT SCHEDULED TO BEGIN JULY 8

HIGH POINT, N.C. (July 2, 2018) – The City of High Point will repair the Centennial Street bridge deck over Oak Hollow Lake, which will require a road closure for approximately 90 days. The top two inches of the bridge deck will be removed, reinforcing steel will be repaired and a new concrete surface will be placed to extend the life of the bridge.

To accommodate the construction operations, Centennial Street will be closed to thru traffic from Eastchester Drive to Oakview Road beginning Sunday, July 8 and will reopen by October 6. The detour route will utilize Eastchester Drive, Hartley Drive, Johnson Street and Oakview Drive to bypass construction, including access to the Oak Hollow Golf Course, Marina and Campground. All local traffic located within the closure will still have access to their homes, but the bridge will be impassable during the project.

This will also require a temporary closure of Oak Hollow Lake to boat traffic from Johnson Street to Centennial Street during the project, so that boats do not pass under the bridge during construction.
