


# Presentation Overview

- This survey is a chance for you to tell the City what you think about several important topics




# Survey Question Process:

1. We will ask a question on a particular topic
2. There is no right or wrong answer, just your opinion
3. There will be a range of opinions shown on the screen
4. Select the answer on the screen that is the closest fit to your opinion
5. Each answer has a number
6. When we ask, use your key pad to enter the number corresponding to your opinion
7. The light on key pad will turn green while you push the button
8. The key pads send answers to the computer
9. The computer records the number of different answers
10. Results will be discussed during the presentation




















