HIGH POINT, N.C. (September 17, 2018) – Currently the City of High Point has an ongoing wastewater spill behind the Riverdale Lift Station off Riverdale Rd. The untreated wastewater is being discharged into Randleman Lake. The wastewater spill was determined to be caused by severe weather. **Public drinking water was not impacted by this event and there is no action that residents need to take.** The Division of Water Quality was notified of the event on September 17, 2018 and is reviewing the matter. House Bill-1160, which the General Assembly enacted in July 1999, requires that municipalities, animal operations, industries and others who operate waste handling systems issue a news release when a waste spill of 1,000 gallons or more reaches surface waters. This notice was sent in accordance with that regulation.
