



NOTICE OF INTENT TO PICKET

A group of fifteen or more persons shall give notice of intent to picket in writing. A group of fewer than fifteen persons may give written notice of intent to picket but is not required to do so.

Picket/Pickets/Picketing - To make a public display or demonstration of sentiment for or against a person or cause, including those demonstrations which may include the distribution of leaflets or handbills, the display of signs and any oral communication or speech, which may involve an effort to persuade or influence, including all expressive and symbolic conduct, whether active or passive, upon those portions of the public street and sidewalks not used primarily for vehicular parking and moving traffic and not constituting a parade.
