- *Planning the Three-Season Vegetable Garden: Wednesday, January 16, 6 – 7:30 p.m.*
Vegetable gardening is especially rewarding in the Piedmont because we can grow at least 10 months of the year. January is the perfect time to start thinking about this year's garden. Join us for a lively session on the simple ways to get the most produce out of your personal planting space.
- *Proper Pruning Prevents Poor Plant Performance: Wednesday, February 20, 6 – 7:30 p.m.*
This discussion covers the tools, techniques and timing for pruning small ornamental trees and shrubs. Doing it right is the easy way to have healthier, prettier and long-lives plants. This program does not cover the specific pruning needs of fruit trees.
