POTHOLES INCREASE IN WINTER MONTHS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (January 3, 2019) – The City of High Point typically sees an increase in potholes during wet, winter months with freezing weather. If the ground is saturated, freezing temperatures can cause a pavement heave, creating a pothole.

Residents who see a pothole in High Point are asked to call Customer Service at 336.883.3111 to report its location. Street Maintenance crews will fill them when road conditions have dried sufficiently for repairs.
