ELM STREET AND ENGLISH ROAD INTERSECTION TO BE CLOSED FOR UTILITY WORK

High Point, N.C. (Jan. 6, 2020) - The intersection of Elm Street and English Road will close due to utility work beginning Jan. 6, 2020, resulting in the closure of both English Road and Elm Street. This closure will be in place for approximately two months, and detours are in place.

English Road is closed to through traffic between Main Street and Elm Street. The detour for this traffic will take motorists southbound on Main Street to westbound on Green Street to northbound on Lindsay Street back to the intersection with English Rd.

Elm Street is closed to through traffic between Martin Luther King Jr Drive and Church Avenue. The detour for northbound Elm Street traffic will take motorists eastbound on Martin Luther King Jr Drive to northbound Main Street to westbound Church Avenue back to the intersection with Elm Street.

The detour for southbound Elm Street will take motorists westbound on Gatewood Avenue to southbound on Lindsay Street to eastbound Martin Luther King Jr Drive back to the intersection with Elm Street.
