Dear Pet Owner:

We hope that you and your dog have enjoyed visiting the Hedgecock Dog Park!

As a reminder, dog park tags are only valid for one year, from July 1 to June 30. Your dog's current tag expired on June 30, 2020. In order to continue using the park, you will need to renew the registration. The previous tag colors were blue or orange, anyone with these tags will need to renew their registration and/or confirm their dog's rabies vaccination.

Our office is currently closed to visitors, but we have other procedures in place to help you. If your pet's vaccinations have not expired, you may renew your registration by visiting our website www.highpointnc.gov/dogpark and filling out the Dog Park Registration and Waiver form. Please email this document to highpointpradministration@highpointnc.gov, or you may mail it to 136 Northpoint Avenue, High Point, NC 27262. We will verify your immunizations are current and mail you a tag.

If your pet's vaccinations have expired, you will need to submit the Dog Park Registration and Waiver form along with a valid rabies certificate. Once we receive your updated forms, we will issue a new tag for your dog and mail it to you.

Registration forms and park rules are included with this letter and are also available on our website at www.highpointnc.gov/dogpark. Please remember that your dog must wear a collar displaying their current vaccination tags and the Hedgecock Dog Park tag when they are using the park.
