THIRD ANNUAL GUILFORD CREEK WEEK BEGINS MARCH 28

HIGH POINT, N.C. (March 12, 2020) – Guilford Creek Week, a joint venture between the City of Greensboro, Guilford County, the City of High Point, Haw River Assembly, and the Piedmont Triad Regional Council, returns March 28-April 4 to celebrate the importance, impact and influence of the creeks and waterways of Guilford County and the municipalities within.
