HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY OPEN TO HIGH POINT RESIDENTS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (Oct. 27, 2020) – The City of High Point will open the Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 1401 E. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive for March’s drop-off event on Saturday, Nov. 7, 2020, from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. This event will be an opportunity for residents of the City of High Point to drop off the following household items at no charge for proper collection and disposal:

- Aerosols, batteries, bleach/cleaners, electronics, fire extinguishers, furniture polish, fluorescent bulbs, nail polish/removers
- Adhesives, gas cylinders, paints, solvents, stains/varnish, strippers/thinners, wood and metal cleaner, wood preservatives
- Antifreeze, auto batteries, brake fluid, cleaners/degreasers, diesel fuel, gasoline or mixed gas, motor oil and filters, transmission fluid
- Herbicides, lighter fluid, pesticides, poisons, pool chemicals
- Electronics and Tires (limit of 4 tires per visitor)

To adhere to COVID-19 guidelines, we ask residents to stay in their vehicles. This will be a contactless event with staff taking all personal protective equipment and sanitizing precautions. Items must be kept in the trunk of your vehicle to assist in easy removal and minimal contact. Please do not place items in the front or back seat of your vehicles or hand them to staff.

City staff will direct all vehicles through and unload all materials. Disposal is for household waste only, not for businesses. High Point Residents can also find a comprehensive list of common household items and their proper disposal methods by visiting www.highpointnc.gov/whatdoidowith.
