HIGH POINT LIBRARY RE-OPENS PARTIAL SATURDAY HOURS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (April 6, 2021) - Beginning Saturday, April 17, the High Point Public Library will be open for visitors in the building from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. While telephone assistance and drive-through services have been available on Saturdays for many months, the library building has remained closed to the public Saturdays since last spring due to COVID restrictions.

Currently, the library building is open for visitors Monday to Thursday from 9 a.m. until 6 p.m. and from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. on Friday. The library building is closed from 1 p.m. until 2 p.m. Monday – Friday for sanitizing of public spaces. Telephone assistance and drive-through service are available one hour after the library building closes on these days. On Saturdays, drive-through service and telephone assistance will end at 1:55 p.m.

Customers are encouraged to keep their visits to one hour or less, and masks are required. There are ten stand-up public computers available for public use and limited public seating. No indoor programming is provided at this time, but the library offers a wide variety of online classes and programs for adults, teens and children.
