### HIGH POINT FARMERS MARKET CELEBRATES FLAG DAY

**High Point, N.C. (June 8, 2021)** - The High Point Farmers Market will partner with the Alexander Martin Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) this Saturday, June 12, 2021, from 9 a.m. to noon, in honor of Flag Day, the holiday celebrated each year on June 14 to commemorate the adoption of the American flag.

At the market, representatives of the DAR will hand out free American flags and provide information about their organization. At 10 a.m., Mayor Pro Tem Britt Moore will read a proclamation in honor of Flag Day in the City of High Point. A color guard from High Point Central High School ROTC will present the colors, and the DAR will present a medal and certificate to this year's outstanding ROTC cadet, Joshua Garcia.

Located at the High Point Public Library, 901 North Main St., the Farmers Market hours are 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. every Saturday until October 30. The Farmers Market features fresh produce, meat, poultry, eggs, fish, plants and handicrafts. The High Point Farmers Market accepts SNAP benefits and offers a Double the Bucks program.
