1. Pre-Season Football Camp **July 26-28**, 6-8pm at High Point Athletic Complex Football Field.
Address: 2920 School Park Road, High Point.
2. Season Practice begins **August 2**. All players will report to their team's practice site at 6pm. Before school starts, practices will be Monday-Thursday, 6pm-8pm. **August 23**, the first day of Guilford County School, practice schedules will change to Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday only. Practice sites listed below.

3. Equipment Day will be **August 14** at Goldston Park Equipment Room. (1302 S. Elm Street, High Point) Guardian must have photo ID available and the child must be physically present to receive equipment. Player weigh-ins will be done onsite as well.
4. All divisions will only have 2 ages playing together. Older Lighters are no longer permitted.
 - a. **12U Varsity** – Unlimited Weight (*skilled position players weight 135lbs or less*)
 - b. **10U Junior Varsity** – Unlimited Weight (*skilled position players weight 115lbs or less*)
 - c. **8U Mites** – Unlimited Weight (*skilled position players weight 95lbs or less*)
5. Attire for Practice:
 - a. Participants are responsible for furnishing rubber cleats (NO METAL TIPS OF ANY SORT), socks, shorts, t-shirts, mouthpiece and an athletic supporter for participation.
 - b. Once equipment is issued you will need a personal shirt large enough to fit over the shoulder pads. Athletics will provide football pants specifically for practice.
 - c. Players can have back plates, padded horse collars, neckrolls, athletic goggles/glasses and a CLEAR SNAP ON VISOR. No jewelry or beads of any sort. Earrings may be covered.
6. Parents and guardians are responsible for transportation before and after practices/games. If your child is unable to attend a practice or game, please notify your team coaches.
7. Regular season games will mostly take place on Saturdays, weather permitting. A game schedule will be sent out immediately following Labor Day weekend. Please make sure your child is present and on time for Picture Day. Games will be played at the High Point Athletic Complex, Greensboro Hester Park or Thomasville Cushwa Stadium. Teams will compete against Thomasville and Greensboro teams in both the regular season and playoffs.
8. A separate playoff schedule will be provided near the end of the regular season. Playoff games may be played during the week as well as Saturdays. **All equipment must be turned in, on-site, after their team is eliminated from the playoffs. Please bring a change of clothes to each playoff game.**
9. All participants will receive an award at the end of the season. Team banquets are coordinated and scheduled by the team coaches.
