HIGH POINT RESIDENTS INVITED TO ATTEND PUBLIC MEETINGS ON AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING

The public is invited to attend in person or virtually on Nov. 16 and 18

HIGH POINT, N.C. (Nov. 10, 2021) – The City of High Point will accept public input on the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding at community meetings on Nov. 16 and 18 from 6 – 7:30 p.m.

These meetings will provide residents with the opportunity to learn about the eligible ARPA fund uses to voice their initial thoughts on how ARPA funding should be prioritized in High Point.

Each meeting will take place in person from 6 to 7:30 p.m. on the dates listed below.

- Nov. 16 - High Point Public Library (901 N Main St., High Point, N.C. 27262)
- Nov. 18 - High Point Museum (1859 E. Lexington Ave., High Point, N.C. 27262)

Masks will be required during in-person attendance per Guilford County's [Indoor Mask Rule](#).

- Addressing Negative Economic Impacts
