We hope that you and your dog have enjoyed visiting the Hedgecock Dog Park!

As a reminder, dog park tags are only valid for one year, from July 1 to June 30. Your dog's current tag expires on June 30, 2023. In order to continue using the park, you will need to renew the registration. The previous tag colors were green, purple or red. Anyone with these tags will need to renew their registration and confirm their dog's rabies vaccination.

If your dog's rabies vaccination is current and you have previously registered your dog, we should have your records on file. You can renew your dog park tag in two ways:

1. Visit our office at 136 Northpoint Ave., High Point between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday-Friday.
2. Visit our website www.highpointnc.gov/dogpark and fill out the Dog Park Registration and Waiver form. Please email this document to highpointpradministration@highpointnc.gov or mail it to 136 Northpoint Avenue, High Point, NC 27262. We will verify your immunizations are current and mail you a tag.

If your dog's vaccinations have expired, you will need to submit the **Dog Park Registration and Waiver form** along with a new **rabies certificate**, either in person or by email as listed above. Once we receive your updated forms, we will issue a new tag for your dog. If you submit your information by email, we will mail your tag to you.

Registration forms and park rules are included with this letter and are also available on our website at www.highpointnc.gov/dogpark. Please remember that your dog must wear a collar displaying their current vaccination tags and the Hedgecock Dog Park tag when they are using the park.
