FOOD FOR FINES COMING IN FEBRUARY TO HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY

HIGH POINT, NC (January 27, 2017) – Love your library, but not your fines? The High Point Public Library will offer customers the opportunity to clear up their library accounts by donating food for local pantries and the Guilford County Animal Shelter.

From Saturday, February 4 through Sunday, February 19, the High Point Public Library will waive one dollar in fines for each non-perishable food item or pet food item donated on site. The food must be unexpired and in undamaged condition, and there is no limit to the amount of food accepted. The amnesty applies to overdue fines only. Customers are responsible for other fees.
