ARREST FOR GUNS/DRUGS

On February 23, High Point Police officers stopped a vehicle at Hoskins St. and MLK Dr. The three occupants ran from the vehicle. After a short chase, all three occupants were caught. High Point police seized two stolen firearms and over 10g of heroin from one of the occupants. The firearms, both 9mm handguns, had been reported stolen from another jurisdiction.

Torrian Williams, 19, of High Point was charged with 2 counts of Possession of a Stolen Firearm, Trafficking Heroin, 2 counts of Felony Breaking or Entering, 2 counts of Carrying a Concealed Gun, 3 counts of Probation Violation, 2 counts of Felony Larceny, Discharging a Firearm in the City Limits, and Resist, Delay or Obstruct a Government Official. Williams was jailed on a \$600,000 secured bond.

Gregory Baskins, 23, of High Point was charged with Driving without a license and Resist, Delay or Obstruct a Government Official. Baskins was released on a Written Promise to Appear in Court.

The third occupant of the vehicle was not charged.
