HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY TO HOST BESTSELLING AUTHOR JANE GREEN

Signing, Reading and Discussion of New Novel on June 8

HIGH POINT, N.C. (May 8, 2017) – The High Point Public Library will host international bestselling author Jane Green at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 8 for a reading, discussion and book signing. This event will be held in collaboration with Bookmarks, the Winston-Salem-based literary arts organization.

Green, the “queen of beach books” as noted by *People* magazine, will read from her upcoming novel, *The Sunshine Sisters*, a heartfelt and emotional story of a retired star actress who, diagnosed with a terminal illness, calls home her three estranged daughters to end her life. With over 10 million books sold in 25 languages, Green has delighted and entertained readers around the globe. A former BBC Radio Host and ABC News live news correspondent, she is the author of 17 *New York Times* bestselling novels, including *The Beach House*, *Jemima J* and *Tempting Fate*.

The book signing will take place from 6:30 to 7:00 p.m., followed by the reading and discussion. Copies of *The Sunshine Sisters*, to be published on June 6, will be on sale at the event. Bookmarks, a literary nonprofit, works to foster a love of reading and writing through year-round literary events, and Authors in Schools program and the largest annual book festival in the Carolinas.
