HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY PARKING LOT RENOVATIONS PROGRESS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (July 18, 2017) – A large portion of the parking lot at the High Point Public Library will be unavailable beginning Friday, July 21, as construction crews move into the next stage of the Library renovation project. Approximately two-thirds of the parking area on the North Main Street side will be fenced in while infrastructure is installed and the permanent market stalls are constructed. The driveway in front of the building that is accessed from North Main Street and North Elm Street, including the drive-thru book drop window, will remain open.

Parking remains available across North Elm Street at the former Bank of North Carolina building, as well as in a small lot across from the Library on Sunset Avenue. There are also several street parking spaces adjacent to the Library on North Elm Street and Sunset Avenue. The work on the north end of the parking lot nearest to Krispy Kreme is approaching completion and will be temporarily paved and striped in the next few weeks to allow customers to park there as well while the rest of the project is underway. Signage will be in place to inform the public when that area is available.
