LIBRARY HOSTS MASTER GARDENER SESSION ON SPRING FLOWERING BULBS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (September 27, 2017) – On Wednesday, October 25, the NC Extension Services Master Gardener Volunteers will host an informational session on spring flowering bulbs from 6:00 – 7:30 p.m. in the High Point Public Library Morgan Community Room. Flowering bulbs like daffodils, hyacinths and crocus are among the earliest flowers every year. Bulbs can be planted in flower beds, in lawns, under and around trees or grown in containers. This session will help gardeners plan ahead for planting in the fall for flowers in the spring.
