HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY PARKING LOT CONSTRUCTION ENTERS NEXT PHASE

HIGH POINT, N.C. (September 28, 2017) – On Monday, October 2, the North Main Street parking lot entrance closest to the Library will close to accommodate construction taking place near the front of the building. Temporary paving to the middle section of the parking lot was recently completed, providing 52 spaces, including seven spaces closest to the building for customers requiring accessible parking. Customers can enter the lot via North Main Street near Krispy Kreme and North Elm Street near Dummit Fraden Law Firm.

The North Elm Street entrance closest to the front of the building will be open until October 16, when both entrances will be closed until all renovations directly in front of the Library are finished. During this time, the drive-through book drops and holds pick-up will also be unavailable. Customers can return materials and pick up holds inside the Library and at two remote locations: the Parks & Recreation Administration Office at 136 Northpoint Avenue on Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and at the Deep River Recreation Center at 1529 Skeet Club Road on Monday – Friday from 5:00 – 8:00 p.m. Materials may also be returned, but no holds picked up, at the High Point Museum at 1859 East Lexington Avenue on Tuesday – Saturday from 10:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
