HIGH POINT, N.C. (October 20, 2017) – The City of High Point Community Development & Housing Department, Community Housing Solutions and Housing Consultants Group are sponsoring an Operation Inasmuch (OIAM) Day of Service on Saturday, October 21 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The program is a hands-on, volunteer-driven Blitz Day that focuses on improving the quality of life in communities in need by way of home repairs. Volunteer headquarters will be at Gethsemane Baptist Church, 401 Wise Avenue.
