HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY LAUNCHES NEW RESEARCH SYSTEM ON NOVEMBER 1

(October 25, 2017) – On Wednesday, November 1, the High Point Public Library will launch their new online research system that will allow users to search all Library resources from one convenient search box rather than move between multiple interfaces, and is accessible on the front page of the Library's website, www.highpointpubliclibrary.com.

By clicking the "Search All Collections" icon on the Library homepage, researchers will be able to enter their search topic and pull results not only from books and DVDs in the High Point Public Library building, but also display results from NC LIVE databases, the North Carolina Digital Library and other online publications and digital downloads. This one search box will pull results from all different locations, making research more efficient for customers.
