**LIBRARY SEEKS INPUT FOR ANNUAL UPDATE OF DIRECTORY OF LOCAL
NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS**

HIGH POINT, N.C. (November 30, 2017) – The High Point Public Library has maintained a Directory of Local Nonprofit Organizations for over 10 years, and is currently in the process of updating it for 2018. The Directory covers nonprofit organizations that are based in High Point and/or serve High Point’s residents – including business groups, fraternal organizations and community service organizations. It also covers faith-based charitable organizations, but not churches and other houses of worship, or religious organizations whose principal mission is to advance a specific faith or doctrine.

The Library produces the directory yearly to help High Point’s residents find the services that they need as well as to facilitate nonprofit-to-nonprofit networking, coordination and collaboration.
