## **HIGH POINT WINTER WEATHER UPDATE**

**HIGH POINT, N.C. (December 9, 2017)** – The Public Services Department has started its second shift and is keeping a close eye on the upcoming forecast. Currently, all bridges and elevated surfaces, Priority 1 and CBD/Hospital routes have been treated and crews are transitioning to Priority 2 routes. The weather transitioned to rain late last night rather than fluffy snow, so slick conditions are still possible with the at or near freezing temperatures over much of the area. The north side of town (Skeet Club Road, Piedmont Parkway, etc.) saw higher amounts of snow than the southern parts of town.

Precipitation and traffic volume declined greatly during evening. Police call volume was manageable, with no significant weather-related calls. Primary roads are mostly clear and secondary roads are passable with due caution.
