WATER MAIN BREAKS AND POTHOLE NOTIFICATIONS

HIGH POINT, N.C. (January 11, 2018) – After winter weather events like the severely cold temperatures recently experienced by the Triad area, it is common for residents to notice potholes or other damage to the roads. Also, very cold temperatures followed by warmer ones is one of the primary contributors to underground water main breaks. Main breaks reduce water pressure significantly and make water temporarily unavailable for users during repairs.

When main breaks occur, the City of High Point posts alerts primarily through its social media platforms, and through the website notification alerts if necessary.
