GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION CANCELED FOR JANUARY 18

Wednesday and Thursday Routes Will Be Collected on January 19

HIGH POINT, N.C. (January 17, 2018) – Because of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Day holiday on Monday, January 15, garbage and recycling collection in High Point had already been pushed back one day this week. Environmental Services staff began collecting Tuesday route customers this morning, but operations were ceased at approximately 9:30 a.m. due to the inclement winter weather.

Due to the anticipated hard freeze overnight resulting in unsafe conditions for both collection trucks and for customers to pull their carts to the curb, garbage and recycling collection has been canceled for tomorrow, January 18. Environmental Services staff plans to collect both Wednesday and Thursday routes on Friday, January 19.
