N. ELM AND GATEWOOD INTERSECTION CLOSED APRIL 6-11

Closed to Traffic from 6:00 p.m. Friday until 6:00 a.m. Wednesday

HIGH POINT, N.C. (April 5, 2018) – In order to facilitate water, sewer and stormwater line construction associated with the Downtown Catalyst Project, the intersection of N. Elm Street and Gatewood Avenue will be closed to traffic from 6:00 p.m. Friday, April 6 until 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 11.

Northbound and southbound traffic on N. Elm Street will be detoured to N. Main Street via Westwood Avenue and Church Street. Closures on N. Elm Street at Westwood Avenue and at Church Street and on Gatewood Avenue at N. Main Street will limit access to businesses and properties in the 300 and 400 blocks of N. Elm Street and the 100 block of Gatewood Avenue.
