## **TRANSIT SYSTEM SEEKS RIDER INPUT ON PROPOSED ADJUSTMENTS**

**HIGH POINT, N.C. (May 21, 2018)** – The High Point Transit System is collecting rider input as it plans for 2018 service and fare adjustments, which will include updates to routes, schedules, fare structure and passes. Riders may view information on the proposed changes at the HPTS Broad Avenue Terminal, the City of High Point Municipal Building, the High Point Public Library, the HPTS Operations Center or online at <http://bit.ly/hptschangesurvey>.

Proposed adjustments include eliminating Routes 12 and 15, adding a new Northern Circulator route to provide service to high density residential areas in northern High Point, adding a new route along Lexington Avenue, extending service hours on all routes and increasing regular fares from \$1.00 to \$1.25.

Participants have until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 22 to submit input on the proposed adjustments. Feedback will then be reviewed by transit staff and changes incorporated where feasible. Those changes are tentatively scheduled to take effect in August.
