HIGH POINT PUBLIC LIBRARY TO CLOSE NEXT WEEK FOR PAVING

HIGH POINT, N.C. (May 22, 2018) – The High Point Public Library will be closed to the public for four days next week, beginning Memorial Day, Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31. From Tuesday through Thursday the parking lot will be closed to allow contractors to complete the final paving of the area, which has undergone major renovation over the past year.

Although the building will be closed to the public, Library staff will be working on long-term projects and undergoing staff training. The Library's online catalog will be available, and customers may continue to place holds or check accounts online. However, there will be no telephone service during the closure.

Because the drive-up book drops will be unavailable during the paving period, Library staff will be stationed at the delivery entrance on North Elm Street from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday to collect returns. Customers may also return items at the City's Customer Service Center at 135 Northpoint Avenue from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., or anytime in the book drop at the Deep River Rec Center at 1529 Skeet Club Road.
